

# 2010 BAYONET FARM ARTS & MUSIC FESTIVAL

## JURIED ART & PLEIN AIR COMPETITION

### About the Festival

The Bayonet Farm Art & Music Festival is produced by the Bayonet Farm Advisory Committee in partnership with the Holmdel Department of Parks and Recreation, with additional help from the Monmouth County Arts Council through funding from the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders, the County Historical Commission, and the New Jersey State Council on the Arts, a partner agency of the National Endowment for the Arts.

The festival will include a juried art exhibition and plein air competition in addition to the sale of original artwork, art demonstrations, music and dance performances, and children's activities. The 2010 Bayonet Farm Art and Music Festival will be held on September 12, 2010 from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at Bayonet Farm located at 41 Middletown Road in Holmdel, NJ. ### About the Judges

**Mr. James Yarosh** is owner of the James Yarosh Associates Fine Art Gallery in Holmdel, NJ. The nationally-recognized gallery features artists from The Moscow School of Realism, including the Kugach family, Zabelin, Kosnichev, Yatsenko, Smirnova, Brusilov and others. **Mr. Peter Trippi** is editor of *Fine Art Connoisseur*, a premier fine art publication. *Fine Art Connoisseur*, previously known as Plein Air magazine, is the national companion publication to *Artist's Advocate* which connects artists with galleries. An authority on 19<sup>th</sup> century art and co-founder of the scholarly journal *Nineteenth-Century Art Worldwide* ([www.19thc-artworldwide.org](http://www.19thc-artworldwide.org)), Trippi's monograph on renowned artist J.W. Waterhouse is considered the leading authority on the Victorian painter and Royal Academician. Trippi also serves on the Board of the Historians of British Art.

### Awards

**2010 cash awards total over \$1000.** Plein Air Competition: 1<sup>st</sup> Place, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place. Juried Art Exhibition: 1<sup>st</sup> Place, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place. There is also a non-monetary People's Choice Award: 1<sup>st</sup> Place, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place. For 2010, three special awards will be presented: the *Bayonet Farm Festival Award*, *The Killian Firm, P.C. Sycamore Award* and *The Killian Firm, P.C. Vanishing Landscapes Award*. Artwork from both venues will be eligible for the awards.

### Juried Art Exhibition

The Juried Art Exhibition is open to artists 16 years or older. All mediums and subject matter are eligible. The exhibition takes place in the Red Barn Gallery at Bayonet Farm from noon to 5 p.m. on September 12, 2010.

Artists may submit for jurying up to 3 digital images of their original artwork completed in the past three years. Although there is no jurying fee, there is a fee of \$5 per piece for accepted work payable on the day of the festival.

Two dimensional artwork: Artwork, including frame, must not exceed 42 inches in width or height. All 2-dimensional work must be suitably framed (unless it is a wrapped canvas), wired and ready for hanging.

Three dimensional artwork: All sculpture must be light enough for one person to handle. Wall-hung work must be equipped with a hanging device. Oversized pieces, ceiling-hung works or installation works are not eligible. Do not submit very small sculptures; there are no cases to accommodate them. Sculptors must provide their own pedestals.

Artists accepted into the Juried Art Exhibition drop off artwork between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on September 12<sup>th</sup> and pick up artwork between 5:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. **No artwork will be removed from the Red Barn Gallery prior to 5:00 p.m. Each piece must be clearly labeled on the front with the artist's name, the title of the piece, and a price or NFS sticker.** Each piece must be labeled on the back with the artist's name, address, and phone number. Artists' materials (pamphlets, postcards, bios, etc) may be displayed at a table inside the Red Barn Gallery.

**Artists accepted into the Juried Art Exhibition may bring additional works to show and sell on the grounds. All sales are subject to a 20% commission payable to "Holmdel Parks and Recreation – Bayonet Farm". Artists are responsible for all sales and are responsible for conveying sold artwork to purchasers at end of day.**

## Plein Air Competition

**ALL** artists are welcome to paint “en plein air” the day of the festival. To be eligible for a Bayonet Farm Plein Air award, artists must be 16 years or older. Blank competition canvases must be stamped and registered at the Artists’ Reception Table located outside the Red Barn Gallery between 10:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. **There is no entry fee.** Artists are free to paint anywhere on the Bayonet Farm grounds. Canvases must be returned to the Artists Reception table no later than 3:00 pm where they will be displayed for judging. You may frame the piece, although it is not required. **Please bring an easel to display your work**, labeled artwork with the artist’s name, the title of the piece, and a price or NFS sticker.

**With prior registration**, artists participating in the Plein Air Competition may bring additional works to show and sell on the grounds. To sell artwork, artists must submit examples of their work, either 1 digital image or a current website address, by 5:00 p.m. on August 14th. **There is no registration fee; however, all sales are subject to a 20% commission payable to “Holmdel Parks and Recreation – Bayonet Farm”.** **Artists are responsible for all sales and are responsible for conveying sold artwork to purchasers at end of day.** Artists’ materials (pamphlets, postcards, bios, etc) may be displayed at a table inside the Red Barn Gallery.
